Competition Rules

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- The competition will be played over 18 holes of stroke play on the Bragbury Course, in accordance with the current Rules of Golf as administered by the R&A in conjunction with the Local Rules of Stevenage Golf Club.
- The competition is open to male and female amateur golfers who are members of an affiliated golf club under the age of 18 on 1st January 2015
- The competition is open to boys with a handicap not exceeding 28 and girls with a handicap not exceeding 36 under the current Scratch Score and handicapping scheme of CONGU. The competition will be a qualifying competition for handicapping purposes. (Active Handicaps only).
- Entries will be limited to 70. In the event the competition is over subscribed there will be a ballot for places. A reserve list will be provided. The Competition Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without reason. Entries must be received no later than Tuesday 1st September 2015.
- Men's scorecards to be used by all competitors. Girls will receive 1 standard scratch adjustment shot.
- Tee times: from 11:09am. Boys: White Tees and Girls: Red Tees
- In the event of a tie for 1st place a sudden death play-off will be over holes 1 and 9. All other ties will be on countback.
- The entry fee of £25.00 includes a meal after play and prizes. All entry forms must be accompanied by the entry fee and Parental Consent Forms (attached). Refunds will not be given for withdrawal after the closing date.
- Competitors are required to report to the relevant starting tees at least 10 minutes prior to their starting time, details of which will be posted to the address on the entry form as soon as possible after the closing date of Tuesday 1st September 2015.
- The number of prizes and their value will be dictated by the number of entrants, but as a minimum there will be prizes for 1st, 2nd Gross and 1st, 2nd handicap.
- No competitor may win more than one prize.
- Distance measuring devices are permitted if they measure distance only. R&A Rule 14-3 applies.
- Buggies are not permitted and competitors must carry their own bags or, where permitted, use a trolley, manual or electric. Exception: Motocaddy S3 – The EGU ruling is that the additional features on this trolley must be turned off.
- No caddies are allowed.
- On completion of each round cards must be checked, any discrepancies discussed and agreed with their marker who must sign it. The individual competitor must then sign and return his or her own card to the scorer immediately. Any card not returned within a satisfactory time is to be regarded as "nil return".
- Competitors should register with the organising committee at the event at least 30 minutes before their allocated start time. A current handicap certificate may be requested.
- The Hertfordshire Boys code or Practice will be adopted to cover etiquette and any disciplinary issues that may arise.
- Spectators may support competitors from a safe vantage point but in order to eliminate any question of doubt as to a competitor receiving or requesting advice, maintain at least 25 metres space from competitors, and should not encroach onto the teeing area or putting green. This gap rule shall be relaxed when helping to search for a ball of dispensing refreshments.
- The decisions of Stevenage Golf & Conference Centre Competition Committee will be final.
- Practice rounds are permitted anytime during weekdays and after 2pm on Sundays at a rate of £12.75. All practice rounds must be booked in advance through the golf shop on 01438 880424.
- Competitors are informed that smart casual dress is in order all day.
